

Family Tree Names

In Arabic culture, last names are from a person's father, just like in American culture. Arabs traditionally add 'bint' or 'ibn' after their first names.

Bint means "daughter of"

Ibn means "son of"

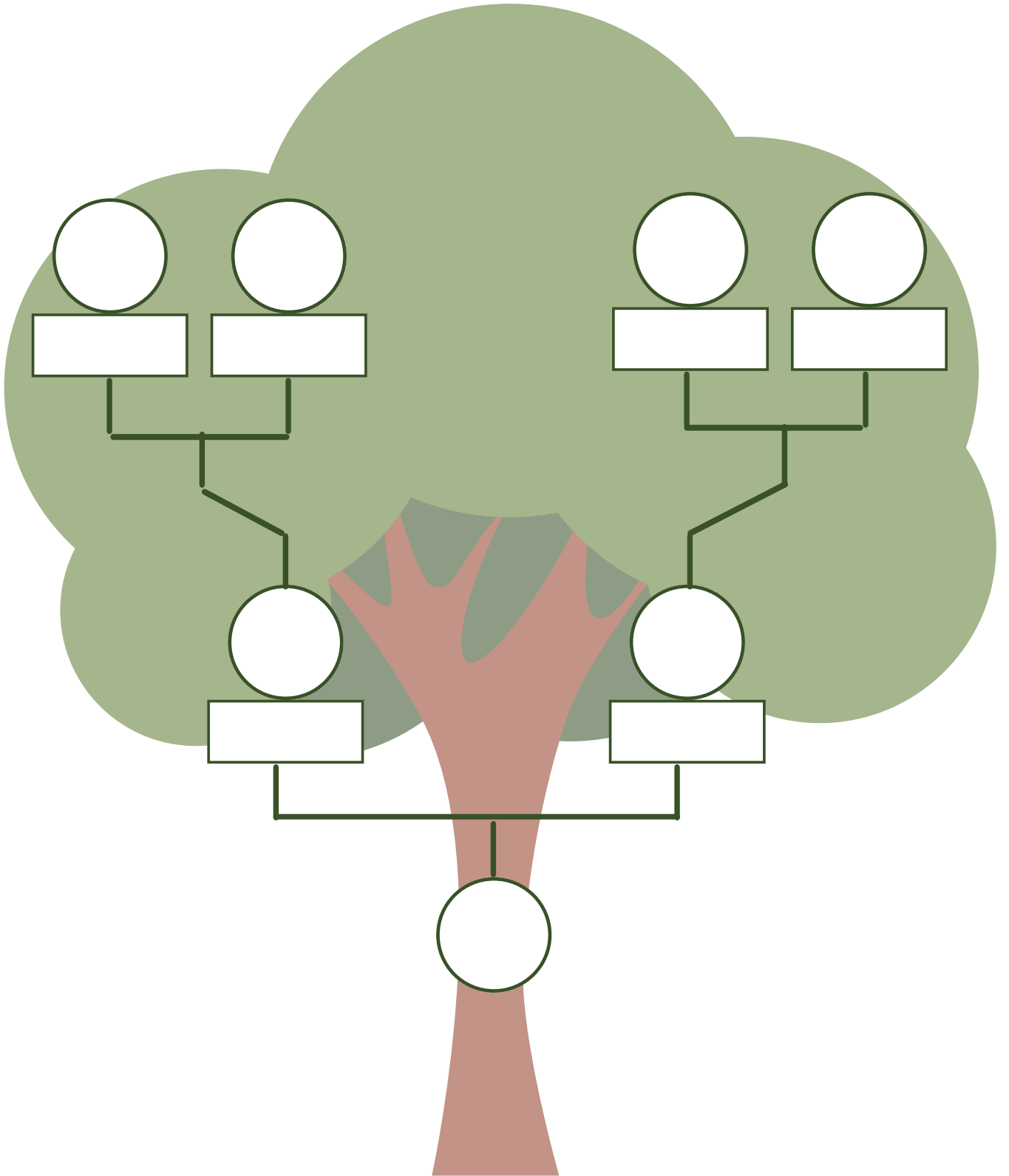
