DAYBREAK PRESS

Daybreak Press, Rabata's publishing project, began in 2014 as a means of giving rise to women's voices.

It provides a platform for knowledge production, creative nonfiction, and positive literature with normative Muslim characters. The Press published 10 books between 2014 and 2021 and one book in 2022.

Daybreak Press also runs the Literary Book Awards and the Muslim Women's Literary Conference.




COMMUNITY
